




CBPS is very fortunate to have such a strong bridge. All the departments and committees are doing outstanding jobs. Many thanks to all of you.

EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

With the on-set of summer many of our members are heading north to cooler weather. For those of us who "tough it out" this is great boating weather. What better way to cool off than to cruise along one of the many waterways available to us. To assure yourself that your boat is properly equipped give one of the Vessel Safety Inspectors a call and have a VSE conducted. The display of the VSE sticker will not prevent being boarded but it will assure you that your boat is operating with all the legal equipment aboard. Vessel Safety Examiners are listed in the Roster.

It is also time to begin preparing your boat for hurricane season. Unfortunately several members of the squadron lost boats last year due to the severity of the storms. Experience shows that boats that were hauled out of the water fared better than those left in the water. For those who have no choice, now is the time to purchase additional lines and chaffing supplies and to check your docking situation to assess and compensate for the apparent weaknesses. Anchoring out in the waterway had mixed results. Chaffing of the anchor rode caused major problems for many boats. Others had the anchor break loose when the wind directions changed. Anchoring with chain and more than one anchor are some options that may be considered.

The Executive Department, with its interest in Safety, wishes you all a safe boating summer.

This was the first Piloting course that incorporated GPS into the curriculum and it was an interesting one to teach. The course emphasized three steps: planning a cruise, maintaining the course via GPS, and verifying the course with GPS and bearings. Rest assured, most of the plotting principles of the old Piloting course were still included. Thanks are due to Howard Bernbaum, SN, and Lt/C Rick Schoonmaker, SN, who worked as proctors and assistant instructors throughout the course. They helped make it run smoothly and are both well prepared to teach the next Piloting course. We hope to offer a Piloting course in the fall right after the Boat Smart course concludes in late October.

The Engine Maintenance course, ably taught by Lt Gene Millner, AP, wound up with its final exam on 8 June. A total of ten members enrolled in the course. This was a two module course and the students had already taken the first module exam. Consider enrolling next time it's offered. It will give you the basics to keep your outboard, inboard or diesel running smoothly.

Cruise Planning is booked to start on Thursday, 7 July, at Wuesthoff Hospital with Lt John Lynn, P, leading the class. Only a few sign-ups at present so I encourage you to take this course if you haven't already. It will give you lots of things to think about as you plan that dream cruise we all hope to make some day. 

D/23 Treasurer

To all who have paid your 2005 dues: Thank You. How do you like our new system?

Nine of the eleven squadrons in our District are now on ANNIVERSARY billing. For current members the only change you will note is that your payment goes directly to USPS Headquarters and your new card also comes from there. You will continue to be billed in April each year. If you use your USPS Credit Card (other cards are accepted) you can pay on line, save postage and will also earn money for your squadron and D/23. You don't have a USPS Credit Card? Then contact your treasurer for an application.

When the funds are received at headquarters they will then send the squadron dues directly to each squadron's bank account and the D/23 dues to the District's bank account. When new members join, the month they join will become their ANNIVERSARY month and they will be billed each year just prior to the month in which they joined. There will be no more prorating (unless your squadron prorates their dues). The two squadrons still on ANNUAL billing will continue as usual. The option is open for those squadrons to change to ANNIVERSARY billing for 2006. Think about it! Your commander has received a password that allows him/her to access the "dues section" on the Headquarters files to get up to date information as to who has paid and who has not paid. With this information follow ups can be done as needed.

Your treasurer should get a form in January that lets National know how much to bill members in the coming year. On that form is a category named "other." A squadron can fill in under this title if they want National to take out for the Educational Fund. If this is done, National will send the funds directly to the Educational Fund for your squadron. Your treasurer will not have to write a squadron check. We are trying to make things easier to process dues, cutting down on the paper work is one step.

It is now possible for a new member joining to use their credit card – commanders have been sent a supply of the necessary forms. People generally carry their credit card, but not always their checkbook. Using a credit card, you can get them to sign up right after they pass the test – before they go home.

It takes awhile to adjust to changes, but this system seems to be have simplified the billing process. Should you have a problem or suggestions, please let me know.

If you haven't paid your dues it is not too late, remember there is no reinstatement fee.

PART II—CO-OP CHARTING - NAVIGATING “NAUTICAL CHART ITEMS”

Last month we did basic work for mark recovery and logging in to the Co-Op Charting web page. I hope you saved the address! If not, the address is:

<http://www.usps.org/national/coch/site/top.html> Use your ID no., click general user and password cocoaab.

This month we will look at doing nautical chart work. After logging in to the Home page and clicking the item for entering to create a new credit report you will be led to the Enter a New Report page. Fill in your ID no. and that of any other members doing the work and enter the percentage of work for each. Click on Step 2 and 3.

Next is the Enter/Edit a report page. First in the left column change the date of investigating and then in the right column get the right chart no. and edition and enter that data. Unless you have an up to date chart the edition is probably wrong, so get the right data from the NOAA link. At the top is a link to NOAA chart info. Banana River chart no. is 11476.

After that info is entered drop down to the area of Report Categories. Click on Nautical Chart items and add new a new item report. You will go to another page. Fill in all the data requested and save as you go along. If any questions the page has reference info to help. Again there is more information in the Guide on the first page of the Home Page.

As you complete the form you are directed to enter the miles and hours of work. This is used to calculate your credits points. Nautical Chart work no longer includes reporting the existence of markers, etc UNLESS you are engaged in doing Inspection Items work which involves team work on the water. Read about that in the Guide. (The Guide is under the Training heading on the log in page) Be sure to send the final report to the District Chmn for Credit.



Boating Activities – July and beyond

July 4th we plan a cruise to Cocoa to watch the “**City of Cocoa Fireworks**” anchored, nearly right under them. We hope you all will come out and join us in a raft-up. Just bring what you need and be there prior to dark. Schoonmakers on 453-8130 are the contact or you can contact me. Most will be in place by 5:00 PM, but later is fine. We want you there!

Our Schedule follows that with a “**St. Johns River Cruise**” on **August 27th** which works better for the trailer boaters. Still looking for interest before setting any plans. Following that is the **Palm Coast / Labor Day Cruise September 3,4,5** and the contact is Richard Fille on 868-1883. I doubt if there are any more dock spaces available at this point.

This time of year is slow and HOT, although June saw a lot of rain. Several of our members are up north. John Lynn has been sailing in the Caribbean which sounds great. I’m sure there are others out there cruising with great success.

And there are problems. Just so you will not think you are the only ones with troubles.. Three members that I know of are fighting electrical problems, although Cdr Mulkey has gotten his repaired. If you want to hear of real problems. Now, many of you know that I operate a 34' Wellcraft Gran Sport. Well, I have jumped off the deep end with a 1984 Sea Ray Sedan Bridge boat project so as to get a flybridge boat again. I have pulled the 454 big block Chev Mercruisers and trashed them. In their place I am overhauling and installing 2 Mercruiser 4 cylinder 3 L engines. That saves over 1000 pounds. I pulled one of the 100 or so gallon fuel tanks, as I, don't see them both needed. I didn't like the Sea Ray flybridge design, so I am redesigning it and moving that helm to the right side. This boat had many options on it and all electronics are shot so they come off. Since I need one engine to counter-rotate like the old 454s, I have decided to do it with Velvet Drive Transmissions and bought one that takes input rotation and reverses it so the wake will be correct. There are many considerations, and I still may put Lehman 120hp diesels in it.

Another member that interestingly tows his boat back north to Chicago in summer, put it in the water for a test ride the other day and found the motor bad.
